The Stage presents a new Series of Performing Arts Workshops

Tel Aviv, Israel – October 2018 – The Stage, Tel Aviv's Premier English-Language Performing Arts Organization, is excited to announce that registration is open for their Fall Workshop Series taking place October till December in which two different workshops are being offered – The Artist's Way and Improvisation 102.

The Stage runs regular workshop series and one-off workshops through which many of today's active volunteers initially got involved with The Stage. The workshops provide an opportunity to both meet new people and hone one's performance skills.

This series for the first time we will have a workshop that is not only focusing on performing arts but creativity based on the book 'The Artist's Way' by Julia Cameron.

Improvisation 102 with Adaya Turkia

This workshop is for advanced beginners. In a fun and welcoming learning environment, participants will begin by working on character development. They will practice getting out of their heads and getting into character and learn how to create three-dimensional characters who have emotion, history and motivations. Participants will then move on to relationship-building and explore how to create rapport between characters on stage. Finally, participants will learn to take those characters and relationships and explore them further in longer improvised scenes.

Adaya Turkia, the facilitator, is an improviser and psychologist originally from Australia and has been practicing, teaching and performing improv for the past seven years. She believes that improv skills are applicable and useful in almost every aspect of life; from work to relationships to basic communication skills, and that everyone should try improv at least once in their life!

This workshop is dedicated to nourishing and cultivating creativity. Being creative is an approach to life. The purpose of this workshop is to encourage each person to find the artist within, the natural creativity we have all been blessed with since birth. Through simple exercises, the participants will get in touch with creative elements to encourage and enable them to practice creativity in a variety of artistic endeavors they themselves will discover throughout the process.

Udi Razzin is a native of Tel Aviv Israel and spent fifteen years living in New York. He is an actor and a director and spends most of his time working in film and theater around the country. He trains groups and individuals in performance and story telling skills. Among his clients are the IDF, Universities and companies.
