Tel Aviv, Israel, June 30, 2016 – The Stage, Tel Aviv's premier English language performing arts organization presents the TLV Short Play Festival, a collection of comedic plays each a snapshot in time, examining everyday human experiences we all share. The show will be performed on July 26 and 27 at 8pm, on July 29 at 1pm and on July 30 at 9pm at Suzanne Dellal Center in Neve Tzedek, Tel Aviv.

After the One Act Play Festival in 2014, The Stage is bringing back this festival-style performance this time consisting of seven short plays combined in a 90 minutes show. Fitting to The Stage's mission of being a community theater it offers the opportunity to many people from different backgrounds to act, direct and produce, and it also brings in a lot of new faces into the organization.

To put this show together The Stage asked for submission of short comedy plays in Israel and abroad earlier this year. From more than 100 plays submitted, The Stage selected plays that cover numerous genres with a wide variety of characters that people will connect to. None of the plays has been performed in Tel Aviv before.

Whether it be that guy and girl that are not quite brave enough to strike up a real life conversation, to the chaos of giving birth (or being birthed for that matter), to an ashram full of misguided monks. Each play runs for ten to twelve minutes and the whole production hosts seven directors and 25 actors with a team of volunteers helping out to bring this production to life.
